STAGE 2 TRAIN

Small group working

Maintain social distance

Multiple groups at venues

No mixing groups (same group sticks together)

Fitness / skills, no contact

Minimal equipment sharing

STAGE 3

PLAY

Normal Touch rules apply Club training, including intra-club matches

Local leagues - ie teams from the same town return

Larger groups up to 30 people
